Rule Explanation Jamsostek Deduction is deducted when code 948 is present on the Employee Pay record.

The Jamsostek component split is defined at Payroll Control settings. For example, total Jamsostek may be 6.54% x (Basic Pay + Natura), and the Company contribution may be 4.54% whereas the Employee portion is 2.00%.

The Jamsostek deduction is the full deduction (in above example it is 6.54%), regardless of whether there is a Jamsostek Earning or not.

Note: Jamsostek is a prescribed Insurance / Provident Fund.
